Your wristbands are included, and colour codes are

- **Red** is for Adults (A) and Young People (YP) with initials denoting type on the wristband
- **Blue** is for Shirejam Team (available to collect only onsite)
- **Yellow** is for the Shirejam Management Team who will deal with incidents and form the duty management team (available to collect only onsite)
- **Black** is for the Shirejam team who have overall responsibility.
- **"VIP"** for Saturday Afternoon Visitors (available to collect only onsite)

Programme Codes on the wristbands:

- **R** – Rifle Shooting Permitted
- **S** – Able to swim 50m unaided in clothing
- **M** – Has a medical or dietary entry on Moo!
- **N** – Has a stated Neurodiversity condition.

Other details:

- If your participant cannot wear a wristband, please provide a lanyard and fasten the wristband to the lanyard.
- Please ensure that the name and programme codes are not covered.
- Wristbands are waterproof, if they break or are destroyed you can get them reprinted at Severn Hall.
- If you are missing any in your pack, please sort this onsite when in the sorting field, where the Shirejam team can assist.
